

SCHOOL NEWS

2017 Enrolments at Just ASC

Enrolments information has been emailed to all current users of the service and kindy parents. If you require Before and/or After School Care in 2017, please go to the St Kieran's School website to download the forms. There is also the Family Handbook which gives a lot of information regarding the service.

<u>Fully completed</u> forms may be returned from now. As the demand for care is high, we suggest not leaving it too long to return them. The <u>last day for enrolments will be Monday 28 November</u>. Any enrolments returned after this date will not be accepted or processed until school resumes in 2017.

Please note the following:

- 1. Forms must be printed SINGLE SIDED ONLY (as the forms are separated into different folders).
- 2. Forms must be returned to Narelle Leathem or the school office, NOT EMAILED. Hard copies will only be accepted.
- 3. Forms will be returned to you if incomplete and 1 and 2 is not adhered to. This may hold up the process of application.

If you are entitled to CCR and/or CCB, the correct CRN's must be given for both parent and child. Your child is linked to one parent and this can be indicated on your forms. If this information is not included, we will not be pursuing you for it. This includes when notification to the Family Assistance Office fails due to incorrect CRN's.

State Transit - School Buses

If your child has a current School Opal card or school travel pass for free home to school travel, and the student's details change, for example:

- Progressing from Year 2 to Year 3
- Progressing from Year 6 to Year 7
- Change of school
- Change of address
- Change of name

BLOW TEST FRIDAY 2 DECEMBER

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BEING PART OF THE ST KIERAN'S JUNIOR CONCERT BAND IN 2017?

Any student in Yr 3 2017 and above can be part of the band.

You don't already need to play an instrument.

If you've ever dreamt of playing now is your time to shine.

Our band conductor, Miss Surrey Hodges, will be conducting a 'Blow Test' on Friday 2 December for all students currently in **Year 2, 3 or above** with an interest in joining the band program for 2017 and beyond.

The blow test is used to help young children try out a range of wind instruments including:

Saxophone

Clarinet

Flute

Trumpet

Trombone

Euphonium

(There are of course other instruments within the band program such as Percussion (Drums), Bass Guitar and Piano.)

The aim is for students to see if they enjoy playing a particular instrument, and more importantly, if they enjoy the sound it makes. Results of the blow test help incredibly with the correct instrument being selected by each child for future enjoyment.

Surrey will be coming around to Years 2 and 3 on Thursday 1 December to give a quick talk about what will happen and answer any questions.

She is really looking forward to the blow test and meeting all the children who will have their lives changed for the better by music.

If your child would like to do the blow test all they need to do is to go on the day. They should let their teacher know. There will be a full band information night early in 2017. We need to get the ball rolling on this now.
