To help support the campaign within our school, and uphold NSW Child Safe Standard 3: Families and communities are informed and involved and National Catholic Safeguarding, Partnering with families, carers and communities, we will prioritise the month of September to educate the community about antibullying strategies with positive behaviours around respect and safety for all as a right of each individual.

Where there is respect, there is no bullying is our mantra. At St Kieran's we have zero tolerance to bullying. When inappropriate behaviours emerge from time to time and these are communicated to the teacher and principal by students and parents, be assured we act upon the incident immediately and in a timely way to educate and redirect the behaviours in a positive way so that we can "follow the school motto: To Learn and to Love.

During the month of September the students will be educated in their Personal Development lessons about safety and positive behaviour, reminded about the school rules and will participate in a fun and entertaining theatre performance by a production company called Brainstorm Productions who deliver well received and very relatable messages through drama to teach students about the importance of protective behaviours and safety. I will also arrange for a Cyber Safety talk to Year 6 as they prepare for High School and a parent webinar by a leading presenter on how you can support your child at home with screen time, anti cyber bullying and wellbeing. 
