How to "Navigate" the New Newsletter Format

- Flyers and permission slips pertaining to a specific event eg. excursions, can all be accessed by hyperlink.
- The event will mostly be hyperlinked in the Looking Ahead section.
- Where a short explanation of the event is included, the hyperlink will also be in the School News section.
- Parents don't need to click on <u>all</u> the hyperlinks. Just click on the hyperlink that pertains to you. Eg. if you have a
 child in Year 4 and there is a date in the Calendar section relating to a Year 2 excursion....you don't need to click
 on it!
- If you experience any problem opening the hyperlink try right click, open hyperlink

Late Arrivals

Please note that children who arrive late require a *Late Note* which is to be handed into the office. As this note requires a parent's signature we ask that children do not fill them in. In situations where parents know the child will arrive after the bell for school we would advise that parents print out a few of the Late Arrival notes to keep handy. These can then be filled in by the parent before dropping the child off at school. Children **should not** be coming to the office unaccompanied to get late notes.

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data

During interviews in Term 1 your child's teacher may have discussed the <u>National Data Collection</u> in regards to students with a disability. The term 'disability' is a broad term used which covers both learning needs and medical conditions (such as asthma). All schools are required to submit this data to enable the government to determine the costs of students who require extra support at any level. For many students this may be a medical plan. Thank you to the parents who were able to fill in this slip during their interview. I will be in touch with the remaining parents early this term in order to update the data for this year.
