the 9.30 Family Mass on Sunday 16. Of course all school families are warmly invited to attend. Yr 6 buddies may wish to support their buddies as they take part in the




processions and sing at the conclusion of Mass. Thank you to Mrs Hocking and Miss Wright for their careful preparation of the parts of the Mass.

Next Thursday, 20 October Yr 6 Mission Team will represent the school at the Diocesan Mission Mass to be held at Waitara. They will learn about the role of Catholic Mission across the world and be able to share their learning with their peers.

Today Stages 2 & 3 attended a presentation about Social Justice in the world. Using the video "If the World were a Village of 100 People" the children explored the inequalities which exist across many aspects of life,

education, fresh water, food security and shelter to name a few. We then explored the role of The Church in trying to alleviate some of these injustices.



Students, in their class groups, will then decide on a course of

action to help support agencies which support the poor of the world. This sequence of learning sits within the Service-Learning Model of 'Head, Heart and Hands'. Students investigate the problem or issue, HEAD. Reflect on the problem through the eyes of the Gospel, HEART and act on the problem, HANDS.
