Premier's Reading Challenge and Book Bonus

Congratulations to the 32 students who have already completed the PRC this year. There is still plenty of time for all the other students who are participating, so keep on reading!

An added extra to the PRC is the participation in the **Book Bonus**. This enables students completing the PRC to gather sponsors and contribute to the purchase of books for not only St Kieran's School but another school less fortunate than us.

Religious Education

Ongoing Professional Development and Faith Formation of Teachers in Religious Education.

As with all Key Learning Areas teachers are required to fulfil basic educational requirements. For teachers in the Diocese of Broken Bay this equates to eight subjects in the areas of Theology and Studies of Religious at a Bachelor level. The Broken Bay Diocese offers teachers the opportunity to up level their Religious Education qualifications through further study. Either four subjects at a post graduate level or eight subjects for a Masters of Religious Education or Theology. Many teachers at St Kieran's have taken up this opportunity in order to improve their knowledge and teaching of Religious Education.



Later in the year the DBB is holding a summit entitled "Sweeter than Honey." These words from scripture indicate that the scriptures are indeed sweeter than honey. Four teachers from St Kieran's will be attending one day of the summit and bringing back ideas and current teaching methods in the teaching of Scripture.

Another opportunity available to teachers are the Diocesan Mission Formation Programs. These two day programs cover a range of topics suitable for early career teachers to those in leadership roles.

Ongoing quality professional learning improves student outcomes in the area of Religious Education.
