Learning and Teaching

Students can often be identified as requiring Speech Therapy or Occupational Therapy as an adjunct to their learning journey through Primary School. This identification comes about through teacher observation and data which is monitored and discussed with me as the Learner Diversity teacher.

The support provided by both these specialist areas, is specific to identified needs. Often, students who are referred to Occupational Therapy have sensory needs or difficulty with fine motor skills. Students referred for Speech Therapy can have either a speech or language disorder. A language disorder refers to a difficulty understanding or putting words together to communicate ideas.

Currently at St Kieran's we have a Speech Therapist who works with students onsite. Rebecca Clarke has worked from the school for a number of years and parents can be referred to her via their child's teacher and the Learner Diversity program.

Next year we look forward to welcoming an Occupational Therapist to the school who will also work with students onsite. There will be more information and details about this at the start of next year.








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
