Many thanks to all the families who have taken up the offer of assisting with letterbox drops and delivering flyers to local pre-schools. We are making a concerted effort to promote our wonderful school as local public schools open their doors at the start of Term 3. Jo's Chocolate Chip Muffins

4 cups of SR flour
 ¾ cup of Coco powder
 1 cup of caster sugar
 1 cup of chocolate chips
 250g butter
 1 ½ cups of milk
 4 eggs



Pre-heat oven to 180 degrees. Shift flour and coco powder into a bowl, add sugar and chocolate chips mix together. Melt butter in a microwave jug, and add milk, and whisk through the eggs, add this mixture to the dry ingredients and stir.

Place in muffins pans, and cook for 8-10 minutes depending on the oven.

Makes 48 muffins.
