We have a hygienist on site daily to clean high touch and traffic surfaces, staff are wearing masks for the next 4 weeks indoors, keeping social distance where possible. Learning and Teaching

Parents would have heard of the organisation and opening of our new STEM room. Our new STEM room contains state of the art STEM resources that have been purchased for our students to use.

STEM is an acronym that refers to the academic disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics collectively. The promotion of STEM education aligns with the need to equip students to meet the changes and challenges in our society and around the world as a result of rapid economic, scientific and technological developments. Current jobs are disappearing due to automation and new jobs are emerging every day as a result of technological advances. We need to ensure we prepare our students with all the necessary skills enabling them to contribute successfully to a changing world.

Our students, up until this point have worked on developing their STEM skills through the Robotics program that has been running in the school since 2016. This program has developed many skills and interests in the area of STEM for our students. With the opening of the STEM room however, we now have an opportunity to integrate much more effectively, all the benefits of STEM skills, across more of our Key Learning Areas.

Through STEM, students develop key skills including, problem solving, creativity, critical analysis, teamwork, independent thinking and initiative.


