FROM THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

Diocese of Broken Bay Professional Learning Program Personal Development, Health and Physical Education Staff Development Day

Teaching staff from Northern Beaches, Diocese of Broken Bay schools gathered on Monday to examine new aspects of the PDHPE syllabus. This syllabus is due for implementation in 2020.

Our facilitator was Ms Nadene Kennedy, a co-contributor to the new syllabus. The new syllabus moves to strength-based approach whereby students identify strengths to build upon. The syllabus moves from a 'Don't smoke, don't, don't' perspective to a more positive "What keeps us healthy, safe, well and physically active ?" perspective.

The new syllabus contains three strands of learning:

The strand '**Health, Wellbeing and Relationships**' focusses on students developing knowledge, understanding and the skills important for building respectful relationships and enhancing personal strengths.

The '**Movement skills and Performance**' strand focusses on participation in a broad range of movements. The focus being on the skill rather than the sport.

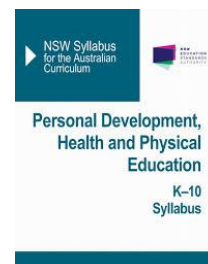
The third strand is an integration of the above two concepts. '**Healthy, Safe and Active Lifestyles**'.

Programs of learning provide opportunities for students to develop, strengthen and refine skills in self-management, interpersonal relationships and movement.
