Thank you to all the parents who booked for the Parent Teacher (and Student 2-6) Interviews. Bookings will be closed tomorrow, Friday 24 March and so I would urge you to book as soon as possible if you haven't already done so.

The teachers are appreciative of the time it takes to fill in the <u>Parent Observation Form</u> and they use the information sent in to ensure all queries and points of discussion are covered during the interview. These interviews are crucial for parents and students as it is an opportune time to look closely at the data that has been gathered during Term 1 and analyse the data to identify goals for students, so that once the mid-year report is finalised parents will have a clear and informed way of interpreting the reports.

Parents must keep in mind that they are able to meet at any time during the year, should they wish to touch base with their child's teacher to discuss progress. All that parents need to do is make an appointment to meet and teachers will always make themselves available.

At the interviews starting next week, parents should be asking questions relating to their child's academic progress as well as social development. This is also a good time to raise any concerns and to identify any support that may be needed for your child.
