Monday, August 8 is the feast day of Australia's first saint, Saint Mary Mackillop. Mary lived her life with a simple philosophy: "Never see a need without doing something about it." She founded the Order of St Joseph's, a teaching and nursing order of nuns who cared for the under privileged in our community

Legal support, health assistance and other outreach programs are offered to those in need. Mary Mac's Place provide showers and a clothes washer to help the homeless maintain hygiene. Mary Mac's does all this without government assistance and therefore relies wholly on donations.

On Monday, August 8 we are hosting a mufti day where students can wear casual clothing for the price of a gold coin. Closed in shoes must be worn. All money raised goes directly to Mary Mac's Place to support the services they provide.


