Dear Families



Today we begin the Easter journey: Good Friday tomorrow, gives Christians a focal point where they can direct their sense of loss that throughout life so many of us feel. From his isolated position on the cross, Jesus was all too aware of the reality of loss; the betrayal of Judas, denied by Peter, deserted by his disciples...

Unbelievably in his time of greatest loss Jesus was able to utter the words "Father, forgive them...". This forgiveness is not only for those who were immediately plotting and carrying out his execution or for his disciples who denied and deserted him; this forgiveness was for all people for all time. We are forgiven by God – but not set free completely. What sets us free is 'doing' the forgiveness ourselves in our daily lives. We are truly set free when we forgive and

show mercy towards others.

Thank you to the children who presented the Holy Week liturgy today. This was a wonderful way for our school community to gather and reflect on the events that lead to Jesus' last week before death on the Cross. Of course as Christians, this is not the end to the Jesus story. When the children return on Tuesday our Year 6's will present the final glorious chapter of the Risen Jesus as we move into the Easter liturgical season.

Last year as part of my Contract Renewal process it was recommended that I take some time of Renewal in the form of a Sabbatical. I will be doing this next term and will be taking the first five weeks of the term as Sabbatical leave. During my absence Marisa Bombardieri will be in the Acting Principal role and Mary Brown (3B) will be taking the Acting Assistant Principal role, being out of class on the Friday and having more time

to continue working in classrooms to support students in literacy. Miss Claire O'Brien will be in 3B on Fridays as well as the regular Mondays. I know I leave the school in very capable hands during my absence at this time.

This opportunity to take Sabbatical leave is a such privilege and I will be using this time of personal reflection, contemplation and renewal to visit the Australian Western Front battlefields of WW1 and then to complete the pilgrim walk, the Camino (The Way) from Sarria to Santiago de Compostela in Northern Spain.

I take this opportunity to wish all St Kieran families a Happy, safe and Holy Easter break. Parents are able to join us on Tuesday as we celebrate the JOY of the Easter season.
