Learning and Teaching

Mid-Year reports will be ready for parents to access on Friday 24 June. These reports are a summative assessment of your child's progress to this point. All grades will receive an achievement grade except for Kindergarten. The grade given to kindergarten students will be based on effort. Grades 1-6 will receive a grade for their effort as well as the achievement grade.

The achievement grading scale used at St Kieran's is based on the five-point common grade scale put forward by the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA). The achievement grades students receive are as follows:
