## *** Assistant Principal

This term has seen a continuation of our Co Teaching program. Since Term 1 I have worked with students and teachers in Grade 2, 3, 4 and 5. The focus for our program has been on the use of multi layered, open ended problem solving tasks in Maths. It has opened up great discussions about how children learn to effectively develop and utilise their mathematical skills.
When working on mathematical investigations, Communicating is an important area of focus:

- Students must be given opportunities to explain their thinking. They must justify the reasons they thought, acted, said or found a solution in a particular way. From this then hypotheses are formed, based on reasons and logical thinking.

When working on mathematical investigations the development of Conceptual Understanding is an important area of focus:

- If students are to have ownership of their mathematics learning, they need to have conceptual understanding of the ideas they meet. Conceptual understanding enables a student to apply and adapt an idea flexibly to new situations. It is much more than just following learned procedures in familiar situations.

This means that as teachers we must provide children with opportunities to work on mathematical investigations that develop skills to "work mathematically". It is important to value the reasons for answers not just the answers, as children can often give a correct answer yet they are unable to explain how they got to that. Equally, it is important to ask children to explain their answers whether they are correct or incorrect as this encourages them to articulate their thinking. Next term, I will be co teaching in Years 1 and 6!

We've come to the end of a very busy term! One that began with "wild weather" and is ending with lots of coughs and flu! I hope you all have a very restful break. Let's keep our fingers crossed for some great weather! Marisa Bombardieri

 and are to be completed and returned to the class teacher by Friday17 July. Here are some helpful points to remember:

- Don't seal envelopes inside each other. You can pay for all children in one envelope however each child needs to have their own envelope on photo day.

- Please enclose correct money as no change is given. Cash, cheques and money orders only on the day

1 volunteer required on the day, judges will be recruited by the PM

- Kool Art (Sand Art)

Craft activity - equipment is provided. Volunteers required on the day

- Paper Plane Flying Competition

Flying competitions will be held throughout the day
1 PM required to plan and organise schedule, set up, rules, equipment, prizes. Volunteers required on the day.

- Kindifarm

A small enclosure of cuddly animals with activities during the day - this comes fully staffed but will require:
Volunteers required on the day to coordinate entry and exit and monitor queue.

- Food

Our canteen will have a fantastic menu on offer and will require volunteers to help prepare and serve the orders.
Our Dads' committee will be looking for Dads/ other family members to run the BBQ.

- Set up and clean up

Our wonderful friends at PartyHire will be providing most of our equipment for the day but we will need a team to set up Friday afternoon/ early Saturday morning.

- Ticket sales and rides

Volunteers will be needed to sell tickets on the day and to help supervise entry/ exit to rides.
