Principal

Dear Families,

At St Kieran's we work together in partnership to develop and support positive relationships that underpin the school's pastoral care policies.

As a Catholic school community immersed in the Gospel of Jesus and filled with his Spirit, we are committed to the values of *compassion, tolerance, forgiveness and reconciliation*. The ways in which people interact with each other in the daily life of the school significantly affects each person's sense of well-being, identity and self-worth and contribute to the culture of the community.

The Diocese has developed a "Sustaining Strong Catholic School Communities" policy that recognises parents as the primary educators of their children and acknowledges the commitment required of school staff, parents, families, volunteers, contractors, parishes and the wider Church to work together in partnership. We do this when we: *support the principal and staff in the development of a Christ-centred learning community; act in the best interests of the students and their learning; develop and maintain positive, supportive and respectful community relationships and are open to learning conversations while building relational trust.*

**TIPS for Parents working in Partnership with Schools** (as per Policy)

- *Disclose fully and accurately any information required by the school in its enrolment process and update this information when required*
- *Engage with students in their learning*
- *Ensure children are punctual and consistently attend school*
- *Engage constructively with teaching and learning and the delivery of curriculum by the school*
- *Contribute constructively to behaviour, academic and other personalised support plans in place at the school. Collaborate with staff directions in all educational and school activities, including camps and excursions, and respect and comply with reasonable requests or directions of the principal when on school premises or participating in school excursions*
- *Be mindful of school grounds as places of learning*
- *Enter a classroom only after invitation from a teacher or principal.*

Also, there will be a presentation by Bryan Starkey, (father from 3S & 1R,) a member of TAC (Traffic Advisory Committee) who will share the findings from our recent Traffic Report.

### **BOOKWEEK**



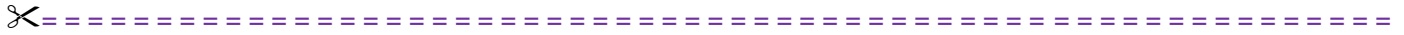
