Dear Families

Dear families,

This has been a big week for me personally as news of my leaving the St Kieran's school community became known. This decision was made after considered thought and reflection as to what is best for our school community. As you are aware, the cycle of School Review and Development will take place in week 6 of Term 3. I want to be able to lead the school through the Review process and hand over the contents of the Report to the incoming principal who will then lead the strategic direction through to the next School Review.

Curriculum Focus Day

On Tuesday Tracy Brown (2B) and Amaris Leong (Creative Arts teacher) lead our school through a compliance process designed to look closely in all aspects of learning in the two curriculum areas of History (part of HSIE) and Creative Arts (Visual Arts, Drama, Dance and Music). Both teachers commented on how well prepared St Kieran's was for this Focus Day and we were highly commended for the comprehensive and thorough teaching and learning programs in these areas.

Term 1 Gala Days Years 3-6

Yesterday I attended the Year 5 & 6 Gala Day as supervising principal. It was an extraordinary day due to processes in place to accommodate the Diocesan Catholic Schools (12) was efficient and well-structured and prepared. I would like to acknowledge the parent helpers on the day and spectators, as well as the teachers and the students for their participation. I was very proud of our school and the collegiality and sense of community felt during the day. Also the attitude and sportsmanship of our students is to be highly commended.

I take this opportunity in wishing all families a safe and happy break as we come to the end of the first academic term. As you are aware I will be taking some leave. I know the school will be in very capable hands with Marisa as Acting Principal and Mary Brown as Acting Assistant Principal during this time. Our eleven week term has come to an end.....and I'm sure the upcoming holidays will be a welcome time of rest for students over the next few weeks!

Thank you to parents who booked in to meet with teachers during the last few weeks for the Parent Teacher (and Student) Interviews. It has been wonderful also to see how the students in Years 2-6 contributed to the interview process. This is a key feature of the focus we have on empowering and enabling the learner and as such place great importance on the **authenticity** of this process.

A few key points to consider regarding the process:

In a Parent/Teacher/Student Interview:

- The student as a learner is at the centre of this meeting
- The student is asked to reflect on learning and set goals for future learning.
- The student (and parent/s) hear feedback/observations/data from the teacher about the student's learning.
- Should either the parent/s or teacher wish to discuss topics of a more "particular" nature it would be best to consider asking the child to leave for that part of the meeting. (Interviews are timed at 15 minute intervals – so ensuring that 5 minutes is left for this would be advisable)

** This might involve situations where the parent wishes to discuss e.g. friendship issues or curriculum/teaching content queries. There will be times where it would be appropriate for the student to be present but I would ask for discretion and care in this situation. Our motto To Learn and To Love draws attention to the school value of being respectful and as adults we are the ones who best develop this in our children.

I hope you enjoy a lovely two weeks without the rush and "busyness" of school life!

Let us pray that we are also keen to meet the Lord in our own lives.




