How to “Navigate” the New Newsletter Format

- Where a short explanation of the event is included, the hyperlink will also be in the **School News** section.
- Parents don't need to click on all the hyperlinks. Just click on the hyperlink that pertains to you. Eg. if you have a child in Year 4 and there is a date in the Calendar section relating to a Year 2 excursion....you don't need to click on it!

Uniform Shop

As previously mentioned the St Kieran's Uniform shop, currently run by the P&F will cease to trade at the end of Term 2 and Pickles in Brookvale will become our provider. The official changeover date is for the commencement of Term 3. When this occurs you will be able to order on line or visit the shop. Online orders will be delivered to the school on a weekly basis.

The Uniform Shop has been run by the P&F and coordinated by volunteers who have generously given up their time to provide the service to our community. This has included ordering uniforms, maintaining stock and providing a retail outlet to our families. It requires many hours of volunteer labour and we are extremely grateful to all our volunteers who have taken on the role over the past years.

We would ask all families to be patient whilst the transition occurs between the school and Pickles. The Uniform shop is endeavouring to reduce stock to a minimum and will not be ordering new stock. Pickles have generic items such as boys' pants and winter shirts available, however items which are unique to St Kieran's such as ties, winter tunics, hats, summer uniforms will not be available until Term 3. Currently boys' ties are on order and may take several weeks to arrive. Please send a note in with your child if they are waiting on an item.
