Dear Families

The school disco was a great success last Friday evening with the children having an enjoyable time “bopping till they dropped”! By the end of the night some were definitely ready to drop! For me, the highlight was seeing the St Kieran's parent community coming together to support each other with supervision, food, first aid and ensuring every child made it home safely. Thank you to all those who volunteered their time, especially the Year 4 class parents for coordinating the event.

Congratulations to the athletes who participated in the **Northern Beaches Catholic School Athletics Carnival** yesterday at Narrabeen. I was able to see first-hand the effort and sportsmanship displayed by each child. Congratulations to all those who made it through to the next carnival. A special mention to Opal B who represented *Polding* in the Basketball final at the state level; the team defeated *MacKillop* and will now be eligible to compete at a national competition next year.

NAPLAN results will be sent home today for Year 3 and 5 students. If your child is absent they will be sent home next week. The assessment is a snapshot of what each child's ability is at a given time and is not the only measure of a student's ability. However, the school does spend time analysing the data the assessment provides and uses it to look for patterns such as growth or areas for fine-tuning. I hope you can use the results to celebrate the areas of strength for your child. A reminder that the online NAPLAN trial for Year 3 and Year 5 will be held next week. This is not an assessment that will be marked and reported on.

Throughout the year, our school has offered a variety of parent education evenings to allow you to engage more in your child's learning. These have included topics such as the teaching and learning in Maths, the ways children learn to read and the *1-2-3 Magic* program for new ways in managing your child's behaviour. There are two more events that will be coming up in Term 4. The first is to do with boys' education or more precisely, the different needs of boys and girls when it comes to school and at home. This will be run by Mr Warren Hopley, a retired principal who

has specialised in training teachers on how to meet the needs of boys in the classroom. He worked with the St Kieran's teachers last term. Pencil the date into your calendar - **Wednesday 18th October**. More details to come.

The second event is to do with cyber safety and educating ourselves as parents to the pitfalls as well as benefits of children being connected to the outside world. *The Cyber Safety Lady* is a very well-known and respected presenter and we have arranged for her to speak to our senior students, parents and teachers on **Tuesday 28 November**. More details to come. In the meantime, we have organised for officers from the NSW Police Force to speak to our Year 4-6 students about the safe and responsible use of social media and the internet. This will take place next Tuesday.

We wish four of our students, Pia F, Kye P, Kyle A and Isabella K success at Monday's two public speaking events, **The Bear Pit** at Parliament House and the **Brother Tony Whelan Public Speaking Competition** at St Kevin's, Dee Why.


Q. Should I log out from the Qkr! app for security?

A. Qkr! is provided by Mastercard and is the safe, secure, reliable way to pay for school items. Registration details and card information are not stored on your phone but are saved securely on the Mastercard network.

As a security feature Qkr! automatically logs you out after 10 minutes of inactivity. You will still be able to browse the menus and add items to your cart, but you will be prompted to enter your password to submit payments.

If you wish to actively sign out after each session, you may do so, however, you won't be able to browse the menus again without logging in. An alternative is to change your settings so that you are prompted to enter your password at the 'Submit Payment' step even if you are within the same 10 minute logged in session. This saves you logging out after each session and logging in the next time.


To turn on the 'Always prompt for password on checkout' option:
Open Qkr!, tap 'Settings' and ensure the 'Always prompt for password on checkout' setting is on (green).
