NAPLAN

Many of you would have heard some reporting in the Media this week, regarding NAPLAN testing. Much of the discussion has been around the fact that some schools completed the assessments online for 2018 and others completed them using pen and paper.

This is because ACARA (Australian Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Authority) in conjunction with NESA (NSW Education Standards Authority) is aiming to ensure that when all schools complete the assessment online, the system is secure and able to successfully manage the large number of students completing the assessments on any given day.

In an effort to make sure this happens, some schools, including St Kieran's are completing an online **NAPLAN Readiness Test**. This is a "practice run" and will take place on Thursday 30 August for the students in Years 3 and 5. Please note, there is no data that comes from the **NAPLAN Readiness Test** as the questions are just standard practice questions. They are not designed to assess the students.

The NAPLAN results for 2018 will be available later this month.




