and the wisdom to know the difference.



UV and sun protection times

Information on ultraviolet (UV) radiation is essential for our lives under the Australian sun. We have one of the highest levels of UV exposure and highest rates of skin and eye cancer in the world.




UV levels and sun protection times are included in your local Bureau weather forecast, the [BOM Weather app](#), and via maps and tables in [MetEye](#). You can also use the free [SunSmart app](#) to view sun protection times and current UV levels. <http://www.bom.gov.au/uv/>

Yesterday's UV index was 3. This is in the moderate range and sun protection is encouraged at this level.

*At St Kieran's we encouraging the use of sunglasses for playground and excursion use. **The wearing of sunglasses is OPTIONAL and does not replace the school hat.***

Sunglasses deemed suitable for school are those from the **Cancer Council's School Sunglasses collection**. Let us remember that the sunglasses are an additional option to our **school uniform** and not a fashion accessory. It is important that students wear good quality, polaroid sunglasses. A **sports strap in black or navy blue** is also an important addition to sunglasses. This will allow students to run around without worrying about their sunglasses coming off. The Cancer Council shop at Warringah Mall is offering 10% off the school sunglasses collection to St Kieran's School.


