- Supervision:** To ensure appropriate care and supervision, every participating primary school must have one Teacher accompany their students please.
- Transport:** A bus will collect your Teacher and students from your primary school in time for them to be at St Paul's Manly for 10:00am, collecting the other primary school students on the way. A detailed bus schedule will be sent to you closer to the date.
- In the afternoon, the reverse trip will occur, leaving St Paul's at 2:00pm, with your Teacher and students arriving back at their respective primary school in time for their regular dismissal.
- What to wear:** Primary school uniform with runners. A name tag for each boy would be very helpful please.
- Food provided:** Recess: Piece of fruit and a drink.
