Treasurer's Report



At the last meeting in November I reported a normalised Cash balance of ~\$16k.

Since then the P&F has subsidised year 6 lunch at the school to the tune of \$1,000.

In the coming months we have a couple of events coming up. The photo session is lined up, while we are looking to subsidize the May parents evening with \$1,500 from P&F funds. The P&F paid a deposit of \$1,680 in late November, so there is not a further cash reduction from the event.

For the photo shoot we have some receipts already totalling \$1,530, but this is before any expenses are accounted for.

The current cash balance sits at \$13,970, with a 'normalised' balance of ~\$13k.

- Welcome Thank you for your warm welcome and greeting to introduce yourself to me in the playground & at the Parish Year 4 Family Mass on Sunday 27 Feb. A pleasure to be here with you.
- Parent Voice gmail account established for parent feedback vs complaints.
- **STEM teacher update** recruitment was not the right fit. Exploring alternative strategy through extension of Robokids program (STEM) and ICT Co-ordinator role. Review at the end of the year.
- Italian teacher for Year 4-6 resignation of Mrs Fabiola Pellegrini in January to take up new position closer to home. Casual teacher filling in until this week. Advertised role but no NESA accredited teacher applied. Working with Coasit to find an appropriate teacher in the future. To be reviewed.





- **Performing Arts Teacher -** (drama, oral literacy) Week 7 commencement of Mrs Vanessa Ryan in role. An innovation program to foster confidence, performance skills, emotional & social audience experience, exposure to in & out of school eisteddfod and speech competitions for students in Years 4 to 6. This program is instead of Italian this year.
- SRC students Years 3 to 5 innovation to enable student voice & develop student leadership in initiatives that matter and improve students' life at school. eg Friday Fun Days, Oval days Thursday lunch mentoring/coaching cricket, soccer, rugby with St Paul's, Manly boys.
 Lunch eating time at Oval instead of school eg picnic.
- Enrolment MOU with St Augustine College & Enrolment Policy (open this link to read)- between CSBB & Augustine Order. Boys can defer their enrolment to Year 7 if your enrolment choice is St Augustine College.





- Advantages of keeping boys to Year 6 A meeting for Year 3 & 4 parents will be held early term 2 to address this choice and educational benefit for boys.
- Open Day 15th March at 9.15am and 6.30pm spread the word and encourage prospective parents to attend and find out the St Kieran's difference we make.
- Oval Sport Mentoring with secondary students from St Paul's, Manly.
 On Thursdays at Oval with students from Yrs 3-6 in cricket, soccer, rugby...
- SRC Student Leadership Initiative Friday Fun Days implement a range of passive and active game stations at lunch time to make play time more inviting, fun & introduce different rotation options for play.
